1. UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY (UNGA CLASSES: VIII-XII):

8. THE UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION ON BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY (UNCBD) **CLASSES: VI-VIII**

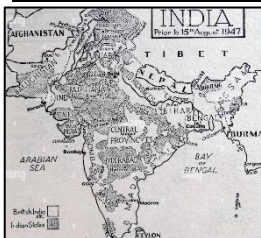
Agenda: Protection of Endangered Wild Life and Threatened Wildlife
